<u>mi</u>	the completion of probation, you <u>MUST</u> make yourself available for a <u>nimum</u> of 2 other callouts shifts per month (generally we accommodate your eference of day or night)	
	ese callouts MUST mean you are available to respond to the VMR base <u>within</u> <u>mins of activation and y</u> ou must be <u>0% alcohol and drugs</u> when activated	
fro	ur agreement to undertake fund raising activities as per current directions om the management committee – currently the <u>mandatory</u> minimum, selling fle tickets for up to 5 hours on a Sunday every two months regardless of mer extra activities

 - Building upkeep and garden activities
 - o Vehicle and equipment cleanliness and operation
 - Vessel operation and improvements

 - o Liaise with local businesses
 - Ticket organisation and selling
 - Business grant preparation and application
- Social Committee and activities
